

### Student Contribution Fees – Career Start (Traineeship & Apprenticeship)

#### Fee-Free Apprenticeships (Under 25's)

Eligible students under 25 years of age may qualify for fee-free apprenticeships in selected priority qualifications under Queensland Government initiatives. Approved students will not be required to pay student contribution fees for eligible courses.

#### Important Information

- Student co-contribution fees are set by the Department at \$1.60 per nominal hour for each unit of competency selected on the approved training plan.
- Units granted as credit transfer or recognition of prior learning (RPL) are not charged.
- Co-contribution fees may be adjusted annually in line with Queensland Government funding arrangements.
- School-based trainees are fee-exempt, where applicable.
- Additional co-contribution fees may be payable by the employer and will be discussed and agreed prior to commencement.
- Full enrolment terms, including refund and withdrawal policies, are outlined in the Narbil Training Student Handbook.
- Eligibility criteria apply, including residency, employment status and funding limits.
